During his tenure at CSW Fulton received Coach of the Year honors while leading his team to a RRAC Championship. Recently, Fulton has guided the Lady Raiders into the conference playoffs as well as named 2013 NSCAA Atlantic Coach of the year.

Jeremy Spering began his career as Assistant Coach at Slippery Rock University, his alma mater, joined the staff at James Madison University in 2004 before assisting the Gettysburg Women's Soccer team to a winning season in 2007. Spering will enter his 10th season as Shippensburg University Men's Head Coach, and was named Regional Coach of the Year after an exceptional 2010 season. Spering proved his recruiting and coaching talents by leading the Men's team to a PSAC Championship and back-to-back NCAA tournament appearances (2010 and 2011).
